

VITORIA 600MM & VITORIA CLOAKROOM UNIT

INSTALLATION & AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

Before You Start

- The product should only be installed by a suitably qualified / competent / experienced bathroom installer.
- Check the contents of the pack for defects before installation. The supplier will not accept any refitting costs if faulty product has been fitted.
- The furniture should only be installed in a well ventilated bathroom at a distance from bath / showers to avoid splashing. It should also be protected from any shower / handset spray by a shower screen or similar.
- Make sure the unit and basin are secured to a suitably strong / reinforced wall to ensure stability.


WARNING in order to prevent overturning this product must be used with the wall atachment device provided.

To install, use screws and wallplugs supplied to fix the unit to the wall via the back brace.

Hinge Adjustment


The unit doors can be adjusted if necessary. There are two adjustment screws on the hinges which make the adjustments shown in Fig. 2.

The cloakroom unit comes with the door unattached, which allows it to be hung from either side of the unit. Pilot holes in the door frame allow the door and hinges to be attached to the chosen side using screws C shown in Fig 1. These screws also offer a small amount of up/down adjustment.



Fitting Ceramic Basin

Once the basin has been plumbed in, finish by securing to the washstand using a silicone sealant (not supplied). Refer to silicone application in figure 2.



Aftercare



- Wipe away any water splashes or condensation after use. Excessive exposure to water or sitting water will damage the furniture.
- Clean with a soft damp cloth with a mild detergent only. Surface should then be fully dried using a soft lint free cloth.
- A suitable limescale remover can be used on the BASIN ONLY if required but MUST be tested on an inconspicuous area of the basin.

Don't 🗙

- Scrub or scour any part of the furniture or basin.
- Use furniture polish.
- Use abrasive or bleaching cleaning agents.
- Allow hot or sharp objects to contact the furniture or basin.
